

An exciting orienteering game throughthe thousand-year-old spaces in the Món Sant Benet Monastery










Participants are divided into groups and, with the help of a map of the monastery, each group must be able to locate digital markers hidden in various areas of the monastery, while their trajectory is recorded via a chip.

You will visit several of the complex's main spaces: Cloister, Refectory, Belfry, Courtyard "of the Cross", Montserrat Gardens, Church Façade and Cemetery. Each group will have to follow their itinerary in a specific order. Before starting off on the hunt, the groups will have to solve several puzzles related to the capitals of the cloister in order to obtain the order in which they will have to pass through the different rooms.

In addition, the teams will receive the order to immortalize their journey with four images that recreate four historic moments in different parts of the monastery, for which they will be given a camera. All of this will be done in a race against the clock.

Time is of the essence.

The forbidden book

A group "escape game"

Minimum 20 participants Maximum 100 participants A strange and dangerous book, a high security box and a 90-minute countdown. Who will be able to open the box before the book is destroyed? A cooperative game set in a thousand-year-old monastery. Full of challenges and intrigues to be solved!

Very few people know about the existence of this book. During the monastery's last restoration, it was discovered that the painter Ramon Casas was hiding a strange and dangerous book that had belonged to the former library of the monks.

Because of its content, it wasn't incorporated into the official inventory, it was deposited in a safe that was specially built to protect it. The monastery's safe is now 10 years old and a countdown has been activated. The participants have 90 minutes to open it, after which an acid will fall on top of the book and destroy it forever...

In teams of 5 people, from one of the monastery's rooms set up as the center of operations, participants will have to find several clues hidden in the archive of the painter Ramon Casas. These clues will lead you to explore all of the monastery's most unique spaces.

In each of these places, you must solve different puzzles based on visual games, numerical codes, etc. But at the end, the only thing that will manage to solve the puzzle and save the forbidden book is the cooperation among teams.

The objective of the activity is to open a backpack that hides an important and mysterious final prize, which during all the activity is guarded by the game master that guides the game.

In order to achieve this prize, participants must follow the stages of a route that will take them through various must-see points of the monastery environment, from The Orchards to the Casa de l'Amo gardens, not forgetting the entrance of the awesome Romanesque monastery of Sant Benet.

- Organized by teams of 4 or 5 people in each, you will have to solve different tests and hidden enigmas related to the space where you will be located.

Skills and abilities highlighted during this game can provide many clues to human resources department, as during the game each candidate ends up adopting a role in consonance to their capacities, both intellectual and personal. Some of the competencies which become relevant during this activity are the analysis of the behavior, decisions by consensus, organization by tasks, control of stress, creative thinking, conflict resolution, decision making...






The sommelier presents the assortment of cheeses and the corresponding pairing, putting in context each wine with its characteristics and peculiarities.
